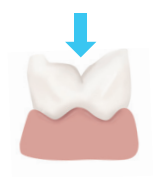


SEALANTS MAKE YOUR CHILD'S WHOLE BODY HEALTHIER

What are sealants?

Sealants are thin protective coatings placed on teeth to prevent cavities.



Do they work?

Research shows that sealants prevent cavities on molars, the teeth in the back of the mouth where kids get cavities most often.

Does my dentist recommend them?

Yes! Dentists and doctors recommend sealants as a way to prevent cavities in kids.



When should my child get sealants?

It's best for children to get sealants between ages 6 - 13.

Where do I get them?

Sealants can be applied at your child's dental office or at school if your child's school has a school sealant program.

Does insurance cover sealants?

Apple Health (Medicaid) covers sealants, so do most insurance plans. Call your insurance company to confirm.
