## **Services Offered**

The SmileMobile travels the state year-round, providing:

- Exams and oral health education.
- Fluoride varnish and Silver Diamine Fluoride.
- Sealants.
- Fillings.
- X-rays.
- Simple extractions.
- Referrals to DentistLink and the Access to Baby and Child Dentistry (ABCD) program.

For over 25 years, the SmileMobile team has offered a warm and inviting environment to ensure individuals and families have a positive dental experience.

This modern three-chair mobile dental van provides oral health services to youth from baby to age 21, pregnant/postpartum people, and adults (at designated clinics)—community members who have limited options for dental care, are facing barriers, and often do not know how to find dental resources.
